Nestlé project EIR comments available to public

The Siskiyou County Planning Department received 131 communications, many containing more than one comment, in response to the Notice of Preparation for Nestle Waters' proposed bottling plant and water collection and transport project in McCloud.

Publication of the NOP on October 12, 2004 signalled a 30 day period during which individuals and agencies were invited to submit their comments and concerns about the proposed project.

The comments helped determine the scope of the environmental evaluation and analysis on which the draft Environmental Impact Report and the draft Environmental Assessment will be based.

Pacific Mutual Consultants has prepared a document composed of the Notice of Preparation, all written and transposed verbal public and agency comments and other documents associated with the NOP.

Bound copies of the document are available for public viewing in Yreka at the county library and at the Siskiyou County planning department offices; in Mount Shasta at the library and city hall; and in McCloud at the library and the McCloud Community Services District office.
